

Minutes of November 18, 1952

The first general combined meeting of the patrons of the four old Cranberry Township Schools, Johnson, Sample, Nochr and Graham was held on November 18, 1952 at the Evans City Fire Hall at 8 P. M., for the purpose of electing officers for the Cranberry Township School Association.

The following persons were elected:

New officers spoke a few words to the fifty-eight people present and then took over their respective duties.

Mr. Wm. Waldron, principal of Cranberry Township Consolidated School gave a short talk on a Special School Child Accident Policy issued by The Colonial Life and Accident Ins. Co. of Columbia, S. Carolina. The cost of this insurance to be \$1.²⁵ per school term. Circulars and detailed information to be given to the children for parents decision.

Mr. Waldron stated that milk will soon be available for children at noon time, he stated that he will decide whether Otto Milk or Taylor Milk will furnish the milk for the children. His decision will be based on which Company can give the best deal.

Parents who call for or bring children to school were asked by Mr. Waldron not to enter the classrooms, but to wait in the Ante. Room. If it is necessary to talk with the teacher it should be done before 9 A. M. or after 4 P. M.

Mr. Maldron said that in two or three weeks the parents would be invited to visit the classrooms. Date to be set later and parents notified.

Mr. Robert Batty was asked if and when we could hold future meetings in the New School Bldg. He said that at the present time the only room not used as a classroom could not be used for meetings as it was being used by the Contractor for storage. The furnace is in operation, but at this date is manually operated. He stated that because of the tile edging being unfinished at this date, the less traffic thru the building the better for all concerned. Workmen are busy finishing various jobs.

Asked about Dedication of the New Bldg. Mr. Batty stated that it will be sometime in the near future, but could give no date.

Mr. Andrew Szily was given a rising vote of thanks for his excellent work as Acting Chairman.

Open discussion was had about the sale of Christmas Candy. Mr. Szily to get the candy at cost and all profit will go into the Cranbury Twp. School Assn. Fund. Price lists to be given to children at school as soon as possible.

Motion made by Mr. Szily that we hold a Christmas Party complete with Santa Claus and gifts for the school children. Motion ind. by Mr. Lollo. and carried.

Roll was passed and \$13³² collected.

Meeting turned over to refreshment committee.
